**On receipt of your order** we will check availability and confirm your order by email or phone. You will be notified when your order is dispatched by 2 day delivery. If your order is urgent, please let us know. If your order is being sent as a gift, we can add a special greeting at no extra cost.

**Postage and packaging** is charged at £12.50 for up to 3 standard size plants (2 or 3L pots). For larger orders please ask for a quote.

If you would like to **collect your order from the nursery** then please call in advance to check that we are in.

If you would like to place your order to **pick up at a show** then please let us know. We would ask that you place your order at least 5 days in advance, if possible, as we are likely to be very busy in the run up to shows.

<b>Abelia chinensis R.Br.</b> A compact deciduous shrub with neat, oval, dark green leaves and clusters of slightly fragrant white flowers in summer and autumn. Buds tinged pink. Ht.1m x 1m	£10.00	2L
<b>Abelia 'Edward Goucher' AGM</b> Compact bushy semi-evergreen shrub with arching stems. Glossy foliage, tinged bronze when young. Long lasting lilac-pink flowers in summer. Ht.1.5m x 1.5m	£10.00	2L
<b>Abelia mosanensis</b> Highly fragrant deciduous shrub bearing glossy green leaves on arching stems. Reddish-pink buds opening to white, pink-flushed, flowers in spring, as fragrant as Hyacinths or Lilac. Foliage turns shades of orange and red in autumn. Ht.1.2m x 1m	£10.00	2L

<p><b>Abelia parvifolia</b> Attractive semi-evergreen shrub with arching branches. Bearing glossy oval leaves and clusters of lilac-pink flowers, with persistent reddish calyx, from mid-summer. Ht.1.5m x 1.5m</p>	£10.00	2L
<p><b>Abelia x grandiflora</b> Attractive semi-evergreen shrub with arching branches. Bearing glossy oval leaves and clusters of long-lasting, pale-pink, flowers from mid-summer. Ht.2m x 2m</p>	£10.00	2L
<p><b>Abelia x grandiflora 'Hopleys' (PBR) (v) AGM</b> Golden variegated, semi-evergreen, shrub with arching branches. Brightly coloured foliage in spring, pink-tinged in autumn. Abundant white flowers with lilac tinge and persistent creamy-white calyx, from mid-summer. Ht.1mx1m</p>	£10.00	2L
<p><b>Abelia x grandiflora 'Radiance' (v)</b> Attractive semi-evergreen shrub with arching branches. Bearing white variegated leaves and clusters of long-lasting, pale-pink, flowers from mid-summer. Slightly tinged pink foliage tips in winter. Ht.1m x 1.5m</p>	£10.00	2L
<p><b>Abeliophyllum distichum Roseum Group</b> Deciduous shrub with open growth and small oval green leaves. Fragrant white flowers, tinged pink, produced on bare stems in late winter or early spring. Foliage sometimes turns purple in autumn. Ht.1m x 1m</p>	£12.50	2L
<p><b>Acacia baileyana 'Purpurea' AGM</b> Large graceful evergreen shrub or small tree. Spectacular blue-green foliage, purple when young. Abundant yellow flowers in winter and spring. Ht.4m x 2.5m</p>	£12.50 £35.00	2L 5L

<p><b>Acer palmatum 'Dissectum Nigrum' (D)</b> Graceful, spreading and weeping Japanese maple that forms a mound habit. Feathery burgundy-red leaves, with bronze shades, turning red in autumn. Small red flowers in spring followed by red winged fruits in autumn. Ht. 1.5m x 2m</p>	£25.00	3L
<p><b>Acer palmatum Dissectum Viride Group</b> Beautiful low growing and weeping Japanese maple that forms a mound habit. Feathery leaves that are lime-green in summer, turning shades of red, orange and gold in autumn. Red flowers in spring followed by winged fruit in autumn. Ht 2m x 1.5m</p>	£25.00	3L
<p><b>Acer palmatum 'Eddisbury' (P) AGM</b> Attractive coral-bark maple with upright growth habit. Bright red shoots contrast with fresh green palmate leaves, turning shades of golden yellow in autumn. Small red flowers in spring, winged fruit in autumn. Ht. 4m x 3m</p>	£25.00	3L
<p><b>Acer palmatum 'Emperor 1' (A)</b> Attractive Japanese maple with strong upright habit. Deep red-purple, large palmate leaves turning crimson in autumn. Foliage appears later than other cultivars reducing risk of frost damage. Ht. 5m x 4m</p>	£25.00	3L
<p><b>Acer palmatum 'Katsura' (P) AGM</b> Stunning upright Japanese maple. Palmate leaves emerge golden orange with pink tips in spring, becoming green in summer then bright orange in autumn. Ht 4m x 2.5m</p>	£25.00	3L
<p><b>Acer palmatum 'Kinshi' (L) AGM</b> Graceful Japanese maple with compact, upright but slightly weeping habit. Deeply cut linear leaves give a feathery appearance, emerging vivid green and turning yellow to striking orange in autumn. Ht. 1.5m x 1.5m</p>	£25.00	3L
<p><b>Acer palmatum 'Koto-no-ito' (L)</b> Pretty Japanese maple with slow growing upright habit and rounded canopy. Bright green, narrow linear leaves, turning golden orange in autumn. Its name translates to 'harp strings'. Ht. 2m x 2m</p>	£25.00	3L
<p><b>Acer palmatum 'Orange-Dream' (P) AGM</b> Upright bushy Japanese maple. Dark orange spring foliage becoming lemon-yellow with orange-tinged margins &amp; tips. Changing slowly to light green in summer and striking yellow in autumn. Ht. 3m x 2m</p>	£25.00	3L

<p><b>Acer palmatum 'Orangeola' (D) AGM</b> Spectacular Japanese maple with arching branches and mound forming habit. Lacey foliage emerging orange-red in spring, turning reddish-green in summer then bright orange-red in autumn. Ht. 2.5m x 1.5m</p>	£45.00	7.5L
<p><b>Acer palmatum 'Osakazuki' (A) AGM</b> One of the best Japanese maples for autumn colour. Upright habit with rounded crown. Bright green palmate leaves turning fiery scarlet in autumn. Small red flowers in spring and winged fruit in autumn. Ht. 4m x 3m</p>	£25.00	3L
<p><b>Acer palmatum 'Pixie' (Dw)</b> Dwarf Japanese maple with compact but upright habit. Deep purple-red palmate leaves turning fiery scarlet in autumn. Small green flowers in spring, red winged fruits in autumn. Ht. 1.8m x 1m</p>	£25.00	3L
<p><b>Acer palmatum 'Red Pygmy' (L)</b> Japanese maple with slow growing, mound shaped habit. Delicate looking strap-like leaves emerging red-purple and turning red/scarlet in autumn. Small purple flowers in spring, red winged fruit in autumn. Ht. 1.5m x 1m</p>	£25.00	3L
<p><b>Acer palmatum 'Sango-kaku' (P) AGM</b> Striking Japanese maple with upright habit and stunning stems in winter. Coral-red young branches bearing palmate leaves which open pinkish-yellow, maturing to bright green in summer then golden yellow in autumn. Ht. 4mx2m</p>	£25.00	3L
<p><b>Acer palmatum 'Summer Gold' (P)</b> Beautiful Japanese maple with upright habit and rounded crown. Leaves emerge orange-pink in spring, maturing lime-green then turning stunning golden yellow with orange and red shades in autumn. Yellow foliage tolerant of sunny positions. Ht. 2m x 2m</p>	£45.00	7.5L
<p><b>Acer palmatum 'Villa Taranto' (L) AGM</b> Beautiful Japanese maple with dome-shaped habit. Attractive strap-like leaves emerge reddish and mature green with reddish overtone, followed by golden autumn colour. Small red flowers in spring and winged fruit in autumn. Ht. 2m x 1.5m</p>	£25.00	3L
<p><b>Acer rufinerve</b> Attractive snakebark maple with green/white striated bark, forming a medium sized deciduous tree. Large mid-green leaves with stunning red and yellow autumn colours. Ht.6m x 4m</p>	£35.00	5L
<p><b>Acer shirasawanum 'Jordan'</b> Stunning maple with bushy upright habit and outstanding foliage. Palmate leaves emerge pretty yellow-orange, brightening to lime-green and turning spectacular oranges and reds in autumn. Contrasting small red flowers. Ht.3mx 2m</p>	£45.00	7.5L

<p><b>Acer sikkimense subsp. Metcalfii</b> Rare snakebark maple with red/white striated bark forming a small deciduous tree. Thick glossy leaves open red in spring. Good red/orange autumn colours. Ht. 4m x 3m</p>	£20.00	2L
<p><b>Acer spicatum</b> Deciduous shrub or small tree with spreading crown. 3 or 5 lobed leaves turn brilliant yellow to red in autumn. Upright panicles of small yellow-green flowers in summer followed by pink-flushed pale green winged fruits. Ht.6mx4m</p>	£20.00	2L
<p><b>Actinidia kolomikta AGM</b> Vigorous deciduous climber with twining stems. Striking tri-coloured variegation, with mature leaves displaying a creamy white, pink flushed terminal half. Ht.4m x 4m</p>	£12.50	2L
<p><b>Ageratina ligustrina</b> Densely branched evergreen shrub with domed habit. Flat corymbs of long lasting, aromatic, white blossom loved by butterflies, bees and other insects. Ht.2m x 2m</p>	£10.00	3L
<p><b>Akebia quinata</b> Semi-evergreen climber with attractive leaflets, commonly known as chocolate vine. Chocolatey scented, violet-purple flowers, sometimes followed by sweet sausage shaped fruit. Ht.6m x 2m</p>	£12.50	2L
<p><b>Akebia quinata 'Amethyst Glow'</b> Semi-evergreen climber with attractive leaflets, commonly known as chocolate vine. Chocolatey scented, pale pink/purple flowers with darker purple centres, sometimes followed by sweet sausage shaped fruit. Ht.6m x 2m</p>	£12.50	2L
<p><b>Akebia quinata cream-flowered</b> Semi- evergreen climber with attractive leaflets. Vanilla scented, creamy white flowers with purple centres, from March to May. Highly fragrant especially in evening. Exotic edible fruit requires long hot summer. Ht.6m x 2m</p>	£12.50	2L
<p><b>Albizia julibrissin</b> Graceful, broad-crowned, deciduous tree with attractive mimosa-like leaves. Fluffy pink flower heads, with prominent stamens, in late summer. Commonly known as the pink silk tree. Ht. 4m x 2.5m</p>	£12.50	2L
<p><b>Albizia julibrissin f. rosea AGM</b> Graceful, broad-crowned, deciduous tree with attractive mimosa-like leaves. Fluffy rose-pink flower heads, with prominent stamens, in late summer. Commonly known as the pink silk tree. Ht. 4m x 2.5m</p>	£12.50	2L
<p><b>Amelanchier canadensis</b> Small deciduous tree or shrub with showy white, star-shaped, flowers in early spring. Attractive foliage turning yellow, orange, red in autumn. Producing edible blue-black berries. Ht.4m x 2.5m</p>	£12.50	3L

<p><b>Ampelopsis brevipedunculata 'Elegans' (v)</b>  Attractive deciduous climber with densely mottled, white and pink tinged, green leaves. Modest growing, good option for covering smaller areas. Gem-like turquoise fruit after a hot summer. Ht.2.5m x 1.5m</p>	£10.00	2L
<p><b>Anisodonteia capensis</b>  Compact evergreen to semi-evergreen sub-shrub with small hairy leaves. Profusion of hibiscus-like flowers with pink outer and dark pink centres in summer and autumn. Ht.0.8m x 0.8m</p>	£10.00	2L
<p><b>Arbutus unedo f. rubra AGM</b>  Small evergreen tree or shrub with glossy dark green leaves. A choice form with pink flushed, bell shaped, flowers and abundant orange/red fruit. Ht.3m x 2m</p>	£35.00	5L
<p><b>Athyrium filix-femina 'Red Lady' AGM</b>  Graceful light green fronds on striking red stems. Deciduous with erect to arching habit, slowly spreading. Protect with dry mulch of straw/bracken in cold winters. 60cm x 40cm</p>	£8.50	2L
<p><b>Athyrium niponicum 'Pewter Lace'</b>  Dramatic deciduous Japanese painted fern. Forming rosettes of arching pewter to silver fronds with contrasting red veining. Ht. 45cm x 45cm</p>	£8.50	2L
<p><b>Athyrium niponicum var. pictum 'Ursula's Red'</b>  Beautiful deciduous fern with rich purple-bronze tones, dusted with striking silver-white. Forming low growing clump. Ht. 40cm x 80cm</p>	£8.50	2L
<p><b>Berberis darwinii AGM</b>  Dense evergreen shrub with holly-like, glossy, dark green leaves. Drooping clusters of bright orange flowers that are tinged red in bud, over a long period in early spring. Followed by blue-black autumn berries. Ht. 1.5m x 1.5m</p>	£8.95	2L
<p><b>Berberis thunbergii 'Chocolate Summer' (PBR)</b>  Compact deciduous shrub with upright red stems. Purple/chocolate brown leaves with lighter coloured new growth. Tiny yellow flowers in late spring followed by small orange-red berries. Ht. 75cm x 50cm</p>	£10.00	2L
<p><b>Berberis thunbergii f. atropurpurea 'Helmond Pillar'</b>  Deciduous shrub with narrow upright habit. Rich purple foliage. Small yellow flowers in spring, red berries in autumn often persist to winter. Ht. 1.2m x 0.5m</p>	£10.00	2L
<p><b>Berberis thunbergii 'Florence' (PBR)</b>  Compact deciduous shrub with neat columnar habit. Striking, small, orange-red foliage, turning deeper red through the season and into autumn. Tiny yellow flowers from late spring followed by red berries. Ht. 75cm x 50cm</p>	£10.00	2L
<p><b>Berberis thunbergii 'Golden Rocket' (PBR)</b>  Colourful deciduous shrub with columnar habit. Bright golden foliage in spring, turns lime green in summer and vibrant shades of orange in autumn. Small yellow flowers in spring followed by red berries. Ht. 1.2m x 0.6m</p>	£10.00	2L



<p><b>Berberis thunbergii 'Lutin Rouge' (PBR)</b> Compact, deciduous shrub with neat upright habit and breathtaking colour. Red foliage turns brilliant scarlet in autumn. For best foliage colour plant in sun as it greens in the shade. Ht. 50cm x 25cm</p>	£10.00	2L
<p><b>Berberis thunbergii 'Maria' (PBR)</b> One of the best golden-leaved varieties with compact columnar habit. Foliage emerges with red tinge, turning bright golden-yellow, then orange-red in autumn. Pale yellow flowers in spring, red berries in autumn. Ht.1m x 0.5m</p>	£10.00	2L
<p><b>Berberis thunbergii 'Summer Sunset' (PBR)</b> Compact deciduous shrub with neat rounded habit. Colourful bright yellow foliage with a splash of orange to edges. Vibrant red shades in autumn. Pale yellow flowers in late spring. Ht. 60cm x 60cm</p>	£10.00	2L

<p><b>Blechnum spicant AGM</b> Neat tufted evergreen fern with spreading, narrow, dark green leathery fronds. Ht.50cm x 50cm</p>	£8.50	2L

<p><b>Broussonetia papyrifera</b> Paper mulberry forms a large shrub or small deciduous tree. Grey-green hairy leaves, to 20cm. Male, long hanging catkins. Female, decorative flower clusters and orange-red fruits. Ht.4m x 4m</p>	£45.00	15L
<p><b>Buddleja colvilei 'Kewensis'</b> Semi-evergreen shrub or small tree with dark green, lance-shaped leaves. Large drooping panicles of rich pink/red tubular flowers, with white throats, in June. Most attractive and unusual buddleja. Ht.4m x 4m</p>	£15.00	5L
