<b>Abelia chinensis R.Br.</b> A compact deciduous shrub with neat, oval, dark green leaves and clusters of slightly fragrant white flowers in summer and autumn. Buds tinged pink. Ht.1m x 1m	£12.50	2L
<b>Abelia 'Edward Goucher' AGM</b> Compact bushy semi-evergreen shrub with arching stems. Glossy foliage, tinged bronze when young. Long lasting lilac-pink flowers in summer. Ht.1.5m x 1.5m	£10.00	2L
<b>Abelia mosanensis</b> Highly fragrant deciduous shrub bearing glossy green leaves on arching stems. Reddish-pink buds opening to white, pink-flushed, flowers in spring, as fragrant as Hyacinths or Lilac. Foliage turns shades of orange and red in autumn. Ht.1.2m x 1m	£12.50	2L
<b>Abelia x grandiflora</b> Attractive semi-evergreen shrub with arching branches. Bearing glossy oval leaves and clusters of long-lasting, pale-pink, flowers from mid-summer. Ht.2m x 2m	£10.00	2L

<p><b>Abelia x grandiflora MAGIC DAYDREAM</b> Compact, dwarf, semi-evergreen variegated shrub with neat green leaves edged in creamy white. Pink and purple tinges in autumn and winter. Freely produced fragrant white flowers, with rose tint, from July to October. Ht.75cm x 75cm</p>	£10.00	2L
<p><b>Abelia x grandiflora 'Radiance' (v)</b> Attractive semi-evergreen shrub with arching branches. Bearing white variegated leaves and clusters of long-lasting, pale-pink, flowers from mid-summer. Slightly tinged pink foliage tips in winter. Ht.1m x 1.5m</p>	£10.00	2L
<p><b>Abeliophyllum distichum Roseum Group</b> Deciduous shrub with open growth and small oval green leaves. Fragrant white flowers, tinged pink, produced on bare stems in late winter or early spring. Foliage sometimes turns purple in autumn. Ht.1m x 1m</p>	£15.00	2L
<p><b>Abutilon megapotamicum 'Wisley Red'</b> Semi-evergreen shrub with slender arching stems and climbing habit. Lance to heart-shaped green leaves. Bell-shaped flowers with orange-red petals from summer into autumn. Ht. 1.5m x 1m</p>	£12.95	2L
<p><b>Acer japonicum 'Vitifolium' AGM</b> Small deciduous tree or large bushy shrub. Broad, fan-shaped leaves with stunning purple, crimson and orange autumn colours. Ht.2.5m x 2.5m</p>	£25.00 £35.00	3L 5L
<p><b>Acer palmatum</b> Large shrub or small deciduous tree of varied habit. Fresh green palmate leaves with red, orange or yellow autumn colours. Ht.2.5-4m x 2.5m</p>	£15.00	2L
<p><b>Acer palmatum 'Atropurpureum' (A)</b> Striking purple leaf Japanese maple which makes a small tree or bushy shrub. Palmate leaves turning red in autumn. Ht.4m x 4m</p>	£15.00	2L

<p><b>Acer palmatum 'Corallinum' (P)</b>          Bushy deciduous maple with distinctive palmate foliage and dense compact habit. <p><b>Acer palmatum Dissectum Viride Group</b>          Beautiful low growing and weeping Japanese maple that forms a mound habit. Feathery leaves that are lime-green in summer, turning shades of red, orange and gold in autumn. Red flowers in spring followed by winged fruit in autumn.          Ht. 2m x 1.5m</p>	£25.00	3L
<p><b>Acer palmatum 'Ellen' (D)</b>          Pretty Japanese maple with spreading, weeping habit. Bright green, dissected leaves, turning yellow and orange tones in autumn. Ht.1.2m x 2m</p>	£25.00	3L
<p><b>Acer palmatum 'Emperor 1' (A)</b>          Attractive Japanese maple with strong upright habit. Deep red-purple, large palmate leaves turning crimson in autumn. Foliage appears later than other cultivars reducing risk of frost damage. Ht. 5m x 4m</p>	£25.00 £35.00	3L 5L
<p><b>Acer palmatum 'Inaba-shidare' (D)</b>          Attractive Japanese maple, small but vigorous with arching branches and rounded habit. Deep purple leaves, deeply divided into incised lobes. Crimson colours in autumn. Ht.2m x 2m</p>	£25.00	3L
<p><b>Acer palmatum 'Katsura' (P) AGM</b>          Stunning upright Japanese maple. Palmate leaves emerge golden orange with pink tips in spring, becoming green in summer then bright orange in autumn.          Ht 4m x 2.5m</p>	£25.00	3L
<p><b>Acer palmatum 'Kinshi' (L) AGM</b>          Graceful Japanese maple with compact, upright but slightly weeping habit. Deeply cut linear leaves give a feathery appearance, emerging vivid green and turning yellow to striking orange in autumn. Ht. 1.5m x 1.5m</p>	£25.00	3L
<p><b>Acer palmatum 'Koto-no-ito' (L)</b>          Pretty Japanese maple with slow growing upright habit and rounded canopy. Bright green, narrow linear leaves, turning golden orange in autumn. Its name translates to 'harp strings'. Ht. 2m x 2m</p>	£25.00	3L
<p><b>Acer palmatum 'Linearilobum' (L)</b>          Graceful Japanese maple, with compact upright habit and rounded crown. Deeply divided palmate leaves with narrow lobes. <p><b>Acer palmatum 'Osakazuki' (A) AGM</b> One of the best Japanese maples for autumn colour. Upright habit with rounded crown. Bright green palmate leaves turning fiery scarlet in autumn. Small red flowers in spring and winged fruit in autumn. Ht. 4m x 3m</p>	£25.00	3L
<p><b>Acer palmatum 'Red Pygmy' (L)</b> Japanese maple with slow growing, mound shaped habit. Delicate looking strap-like leaves emerging red-purple and turning red/scarlet in autumn. Small purple flowers in spring, red winged fruit in autumn. Ht. 1.5m x 1m</p>	£25.00	3L
<p><b>Acer palmatum 'Sango-kaku' (P) AGM</b> Striking Japanese maple with upright habit and stunning stems in winter. Coral-red young branches bearing palmate leaves which open pinkish-yellow, maturing to bright green in summer then golden yellow in autumn. Ht. 4mx2m</p>	£25.00	3L
<p><b>Acer palmatum 'Starfish' (PBR)</b> Attractive small Japanese maple, slow growing with upright habit. Starfish-like red-purple palmate leaves that intensify in colour through autumn, providing a fiery display. Perfect small tree or for the patio. Ht.2m x 1m</p>	£25.00 £35.00	3L 5L
<p><b>Acer palmatum 'Summer Gold' (P)</b> Beautiful Japanese maple with upright habit and rounded crown. <p><b>Acer palmatum 'Villa Taranto' (L) AGM</b> Beautiful Japanese maple with dome-shaped habit. <p><b>Arbutus unedo</b> Evergreen tree or shrub with glossy dark green leaves and attractive shredding red-brown bark. White bell-shaped flowers, sometimes pink tinged. Abundant orange/red strawberry-like fruit in autumn. Ht.5m x 4m</p>	£20.00	5L
<p><b>Arbutus unedo 'Atlantic'</b> Small evergreen tree or shrub with glossy dark green leaves. A choice form with profuse, bell shaped, white flowers and abundant orange/red fruit, even on young plants. Ht. 2.5m x 2.5m</p>	£15.00	2L
<p><b>Arbutus unedo 'Compacta'</b> Compact evergreen shrub with glossy dark green leaves and attractive shredding red-brown bark. White bell-shaped flowers, sometimes pink tinged. Orange/red strawberry-like fruit in autumn. Ht.2.5m x 2m</p>	£15.00	2L
<p><b>Athyrium filix-femina 'Red Lady' AGM</b> Graceful light green fronds on striking red stems. Deciduous with erect to arching habit, slowly spreading. Protect with dry mulch of straw/bracken in cold winters. 60cm x 40cm</p>	£8.95	2L
<p><b>Athyrium niponicum var. pictum</b> Beautiful deciduous fern dusted with striking silver-white and with rich purple-bronze tones along the frond centre. Forming low growing clump. Ht.30cm x 30cm</p>	£8.95	2L
<p><b>Athyrium otophorum var. okanum AGM</b> Deciduous clump forming fern with broad, arching bipinnate leaves. Light yellow-green colour of leaves contrasts with dark purple-red stalks and midribs. Ht.0.8m x 0.5m</p>	£8.95	2L
<p><b>Berberis darwinii AGM</b> Dense evergreen shrub with holly-like, glossy, dark green leaves. Drooping clusters of bright orange flowers that are tinged red in bud, over a long period in early spring. Followed by blue-black autumn berries. Ht. 1.5m x 1.5m</p>	£10.00	2L
<p><b>Berberis thunbergia f. atropurpurea 'Admiration' (PBR) AGM</b> Dwarf deciduous shrub with rounded compact habit. Attractive rich red foliage with narrow yellow/green margin. Brilliant autumn foliage and bright red berries. Ht.50cm x 50cm</p>	£10.00	2L
