<b>Abelia chinensis 'Green Dragon' (PBR)</b> Excellent deciduous shrub with compact habit and oval, dark green leaves that redden in autumn. Prolific clusters of scented, trumpet-shaped, pale pink flowers, long-lasting from summer through to autumn. Ht.1m x 1m	£15.00	2L
<b>Abelia x grandiflora</b> Attractive semi-evergreen shrub with arching branches. Bearing glossy oval leaves and clusters of long-lasting, pale-pink flowers from mid-summer. Ht.2m x 2m	£14.00	2L
<b>Abelia x grandiflora 'Radiance' (V)</b> Attractive semi-evergreen shrub with arching branches. Bearing white variegated leaves and clusters of long-lasting, pale-pink, flowers from mid-summer. Slightly tinged pink foliage tips in winter. Ht.1m x 1.5m	£14.00	2L
<b>Acer japonicum 'Aconitifolium' AGM</b> Attractive maple with bushy rounded habit. Large, deeply lobed and cut, mid-green leaves turning rich orange and crimson shades in autumn. Small red flowers hanging beneath shoots in spring. Ht.4m x 4m	£50.00	5L

<p><b>Acer japonicum 'Attaryi'</b> Deciduous tree with round-topped, upright habit. Large ferny deep-green leaves that are deeply divided, turning brilliant scarlet and orange/yellow in autumn. Inconspicuous red-purple flowers in spring followed by red-flushed winged fruit. Ht.5m x 4m</p>	£30.00	3L
<p><b>Acer palmatum 'Aratama' (Dw)</b> Stunning dwarf Japanese maple. Deciduous with dense, rounded habit. Brick red palmate leaves in spring, maturing to deeper plum-red with orange-red flushes. An array of crimson, oranges and purple in autumn. Ht.1.2m x 1.5m</p>	£30.00	3L
<p><b>Acer palmatum 'Beni-otake' (L)</b> Attractive deciduous tree with upright vase-shaped habit, maturing with rounded shape. Scarlet strap-like leaflets appear in spring, turn purplish-red and green in summer, then become crimson in autumn. Ht. 3m x 2.5m</p>	£30.00	3L
<p><b>Acer palmatum 'Bloodgood' (A) AGM</b> One of the best purple leaved maples. Deciduous with upright, broad-topped habit. Rich red/purple palmate leaves with bright crimson and blood red autumn colours. Inconspicuous purple flowers followed by red winged fruits. Ht. 5m x 4m</p>	£30.00	3L
<p><b>Acer palmatum 'Bonnie Bergman'</b> Beautiful deciduous Japanese maple with upright, rounded habit. Palmate leaves emerge bright green, maturing darker and turning outstanding shades of orange and red in autumn. Ht. 2.5m x 2m</p>	£30.00	3L
<p><b>Acer palmatum 'Burgundy Lace' (M) AGM</b> Attractive deciduous shrub or small tree with spreading habit and long slender palmate leaves that are finely toothed. Red-purple foliage in spring turns fiery purple and scarlet in autumn. Ht. 2.5m x 2.5m</p>	£50.00	5L
<p><b>Acer palmatum 'Chitose-yama' (M) AGM</b> Graceful Japanese maple, deciduous with compact mound habit. Palmate leaves emerge light red, turning bronze green then scarlet in autumn. Ht. 1.5m x 1.5m</p>	£30.00	3L
<p><b>Acer palmatum 'Dissectum Nigrum' (D)</b> Graceful, spreading and weeping Japanese maple that forms a mound habit. Feathery burgundy-red leaves, with bronze shades, turning red in autumn. <p><b>Acer palmatum 'Enkan' (L)</b> Small upright Japanese maple. Deeply divided linear-lobed leaves are dark wine red in colour, turning vivid red in autumn. Ht. 1.5m x 1.5m</p>	£30.00	3L
<p><b>Acer palmatum 'Ginko-san'</b> Dainty, deciduous Japanese maple with compact habit. Leaves emerge shrimp-pink, turning to reddish-green in summer, then become bright scarlet in autumn. Ht. 1m x 1m</p>	£30.00	3L
<p><b>Acer palmatum 'Green Trompenburg' (M)</b> Attractive deciduous, Japanese maple with upright habit. Distinctive palmate leaves with recurved margins, lime green in spring often tinted red at margins, greener in summer and orange and yellow in autumn. Ht. 4m x 2.5m</p>	£30.00	3L

<p><b>Acer palmatum 'Katsura' (P) AGM</b> Stunning upright Japanese maple. Palmate leaves emerge golden orange with pink tips in spring, becoming green in summer then bright orange in autumn. Ht. 4m x 2.5m</p>	£30.00	3L
<p><b>Acer palmatum 'Kinshi' (L) AGM</b> Graceful Japanese maple with compact, upright but slightly weeping habit. Deeply cut linear leaves give a feathery appearance, emerging vivid green and turning yellow to striking orange in autumn. Ht. 1.5m x 1.5m</p>	£30.00 £60.00	3L 15L
<p><b>Acer palmatum 'Komachi hime' (Dw)</b> Dwarf deciduous shrub-like maple with low dense form. Attractive red edges to its palmate yellow-green leaves. Colours darken in summer. Ht. 1m x 1.5m</p>	£30.00	3L
<p><b>Acer palmatum 'Koto-no-ito' (L)</b> Pretty Japanese maple with slow growing upright habit and rounded canopy. Bright green, narrow linear leaves, turning golden orange in autumn. Its name translates to 'harp strings'. Ht. 2m x 2m</p>	£30.00	3L
<p><b>Acer palmatum 'Linearilobum' (L)</b> Graceful Japanese maple, with compact upright habit and rounded crown. Deeply divided palmate leaves with narrow lobes. Fresh green in spring becoming tinged with orange in summer and turning bright yellow in autumn. Ht.4m x4m</p>	£30.00	3L
<p><b>Acer palmatum 'Linearilobum Rubrum' (L)</b> Graceful Japanese maple, with compact upright habit and rounded crown. Deeply divided palmate leaves with narrow lobes. Shades of bronze and green turning bright red in autumn. Ht.4m x4m</p>	£30.00	3L

<p><b>Acer palmatum 'Mikazuki' (M/v)</b> Distinctive and unique Japanese maple. Deciduous with upright habit. Deeply divided palmate leaves emerge bright pink with green veins, turning green with hints of cream and darker veins in summer then bright orange in autumn. Ht.2.5m x1.5m</p>	£30.00	3L
<p><b>Acer palmatum 'Orange-Dream' (P) AGM</b> Upright bushy Japanese maple. Dark orange spring foliage becoming lemon-yellow with orange-tinged margins &amp; tips. Changing slowly to light green in summer and striking yellow in autumn. Ht. 3m x 2m</p>	£30.00	3L
<p><b>Acer palmatum 'Ornatum' (D) AGM</b> Excellent deciduous Japanese maple with weeping, mound forming habit. Finely dissected leaves emerge orange-red, maturing bronze-green then fiery orange-red in autumn. Ht. 2.5m x 1.5m</p>	£30.00	3L
<p><b>Acer palmatum 'Red Pygmy' (L) AGM</b> Japanese maple with slow growing, mound shaped habit. Delicate looking strap-like leaves emerging red-purple and turning red/scarlet in autumn. Small purple flowers in spring, red winged fruit in autumn. Ht. 1.5m x 1m</p>	£30.00	3L
<p><b>Acer palmatum 'Seiryū' (D) AGM</b> Beautiful deciduous Japanese maple with upright columnar habit. Deeply dissected, lacy, light-green leaves, emerging with reddish tips and turning spectacular orange, yellow and red colours in autumn. Ht. 3.5m x 2.5m</p>	£30.00	3L
<p><b>Acer palmatum 'Shin-deshōjō' (P) AGM</b> Stunning, compact and bushy, deciduous Japanese maple known for its vibrant spring colour. Leaves emerge scarlet red, turning shrimp pink and bronze-green in summer then reddish-orange in autumn. Ht.1.5m x 1.5m</p>	£30.00	3L
<p><b>Acer palmatum 'Shishi-gashira' (P) AGM</b> Dense, bushy, Japanese maple with distinctive upright habit. Masses of small dark green leaves that turn soft orange in autumn. Ht. 2.5m x 1.5m</p>	£30.00	3L
<p><b>Acer palmatum 'Starfish' (PBR)</b> Attractive small Japanese maple, slow growing with upright habit. Starfish-like red-purple palmate leaves that intensify in colour through autumn, providing a fiery display. Perfect small tree or for the patio. Ht. 2m x 1m</p>	£30.00	3L
<p><b>Acer palmatum 'Sumi-nagashi' (M)</b> Spectacular deciduous Japanese maple. Strong growth with good vase-shape habit, broadening with age. Palmate leaves emerge red-purple darkening to deep maroon in summer before turning bright red in autumn. Ht. 3m x 2m</p>	£30.00	3L
<p><b>Acer palmatum 'Tamukeyama' (D)</b> Deciduous acer with cascading shoots bearing finely dissected, burgundy-red, leaves. Mound forming habit. Foliage turning orange and brighter red in autumn. Ht. 1.5m x 2.5m</p>	£30.00	3L

<p><b>Acer palmatum 'Trompenburg' (M) AGM</b>  Outstanding, deciduous,  Japanese maple with upright habit. Distinctive palmate leaves with recurved margins, deep red-purple in spring, greener in summer and orange-red in autumn. Ht. 3m x 2.5m</p>	£30.00	3L
<p><b>Acer palmatum 'Twombly's Red Sentinel'</b>  Attractive Japanese maple with dense, upright, columnar habit, eventually spreading as it ages. Palmate leaves emerging bright red, maturing purple-red or reddish green. Red shades in autumn. Ht.3m x 2m</p>	£30.00	3L
<p><b>Acer palmatum 'Uki-gumo' (P/v)</b>  Commonly known as Floating Cloud Maple, this deciduous tree has stunning foliage. Leaves are a unique blend of white, mottled green and some pink tips and edges. Best grown in the partial shade to avoid scorching. Ht.2.5m x 1.5m</p>	£30.00	3L
<p><b>Acer palmatum 'Villa Taranto' (L) AGM</b>  Beautiful Japanese maple with dome-shaped habit. Attractive strap-like leaves emerge reddish and mature green with reddish overtone, followed by golden autumn colour. Small red flowers in spring and winged fruit in autumn. <p><b>Acer shirasawanum 'Jordan'</b>  Stunning maple with bushy upright habit and outstanding foliage. Palmate leaves emerge pretty yellow-orange, brightening to lime-green and turning spectacular oranges and reds in autumn. Contrasting red flowers and winged fruits. Ht.3m x 2m</p>	£30.00	3L
<p><b>Acer shirasawanum MOONRISE</b>  Stunning maple with bushy upright habit and outstanding foliage. Palmate leaves emerge bright red, turning lime green as they mature. Spectacular oranges and reds in autumn. Contrasting red flowers and winged fruits. Ht.2m x 2m</p>	£30.00	3L
<p><b>Agapanthus 'Silver Lining'</b>  A striking new hybrid with unique form. Clump forming deciduous perennial with lush green stap-like leaves. Sturdy, upright stems of semi-pendulous, white blooms with faint lilac stripes from July-September. Ht.75cm x 45cm</p>	£12.50	2L
<p><b>Akebia quinata</b>  Semi-evergreen climber with attractive leaflets, commonly known as chocolate vine. Chocolatey scented, violet-purple flowers, sometimes followed by sweet sausage shaped fruit. Ht.6m x 2m</p>	£18.50	2L
<p><b>Amelanchier canadensis</b>  Small deciduous tree or shrub with showy white, star-shaped, flowers in early spring. Attractive foliage turning yellow, orange, red in autumn. Producing edible blue-black berries. Ht. 4m x 2.5m</p>	£15.00	3L

<p><b>Anisodonteia capensis AGM</b> Compact evergreen to semi-evergreen sub-shrub with small hairy leaves. Profusion of hibiscus-like flowers with pink outer and dark pink centres in summer and autumn. Ht. 80cm x 80cm</p>	£15.00	2L
<p><b>Anisodonteia capensis 'Carnival Lights Cotton Candy Pink' (PBR)</b> Bushy evergreen sub-shrub with deeply lobed, fuzzy, grey-green foliage. Hibiscus-like, candy pink flowers, with darker veins and centre, borne profusely throughout summer. Ht. 80cm x 60cm</p>	£15.00	2L
<p><b>Anisodonteia capensis 'Carnival Lights Parade' (PBR)</b> Bushy evergreen sub-shrub with deeply lobed, fuzzy, grey-green foliage. Hibiscus-like, deep magenta pink flowers, with darker veins and centre, borne profusely throughout summer. Ht. 80cm x 60cm</p>	£15.00	2L
<p><b>Anisodonteia capensis ELEGANS PRINCESS (PBR)</b> Compact evergreen to semi-evergreen sub-shrub with small hairy leaves. Profusion of hibiscus-like flowers, with pink outer and dark pink centres, in summer and autumn. Loved by butterflies and bees. Ht.1m x 0.8m</p>	£15.00	2L
<p><b>Arbutus unedo 'Atlantic' AGM</b> Small evergreen tree or shrub with glossy dark green leaves. A choice form with profuse, bell shaped, white flowers and abundant orange/red fruit, even on young plants. Ht. 2.5m x 2.5m</p>	£25.00	5L
<p><b>Berberis darwinii AGM</b> Dense evergreen shrub with holly-like, glossy, dark green leaves. Drooping clusters of bright orange flowers that are tinged red in bud, over a long period in early spring. Followed by blue-black autumn berries. Ht. 1.5m x 1.5m</p>	£12.95	2L
<p><b>Berberis thunbergii 'Desperados' (PBR)</b> Deciduous shrub with broad, rounded habit. Spectacular bright foliage that changes colour. Dark orange new shoots, changing to red in summer, greening in older foliage which provides beautiful contrast. Ht. 60cm x 60xm</p>	£12.95	2L
<p><b>Berberis thunbergii f. atropurpurea 'Red Pillar'</b> Deciduous shrub, initially columnar, slightly spreading with age. Reddish-purple leaves that turn brilliant crimson in autumn. Yellow flowers in spring, followed by red berries. Ht.1.2m x 1m</p>	£12.95	2L
<p><b>Berberis thunbergii 'Golden Rocket' (PBR)</b> Colourful deciduous shrub with columnar habit. Bright golden foliage in spring, turns lime green in summer and vibrant shades of orange in autumn. Small yellow flowers in spring followed by red berries. Ht. 1.2m x 0.6m</p>	£12.95	2L
<p><b>Berberis thunbergii 'Orange Rocket' (PBR)</b> Compact, columnar deciduous shrub. Red/orange young foliage turning brighter red in autumn. Yellow flowers in spring, bright red berries late summer/autumn. Ht.1.2m x 0.6m</p>	£12.95	2L

<p><b>Betula × plettkei 'Golden Treasure' (PBR)</b> Dwarf birch with delightful golden foliage that is finely serrated around the edge. Dramatic shades of red and yellow in autumn. Compact, bushy habit, can be clipped to shape. Ht. 75cm x 75cm</p>	£20.00	3L
<p><b>Buddleja davidii 'Prince Charming' (Monarch Series) (PBR)</b> Compact, semi-evergreen shrub ideal for the smaller space or patio. Attractive lance shaped grey-green leaves. Masses of scented panicles, unique cerise-pink flowers from summer to autumn. Loved by butterflies and bees. Ht.1.2 x 1.2</p>	£13.50	2L
<p><b>Buddleja Little Ruby (Butterfly Candy Series) (PBR)</b> Compact deciduous shrub, ideal for the smaller space or patio. Lance-shaped green leaves. Profuse conical sprays of deep red-pink flowers, from midsummer to early autumn. Loved by butterflies and other pollinators. Ht. 80cm x 80cm</p>	£13.50	2L
<p><b>Callicarpa bodinieri Magical Deep Purple ('Kolmdepu' PBR)</b> Medium sized deciduous shrub of upright habit. Leaves bronze-purple when young, turning green then rosy-pink in autumn. Free-fruited with dense clusters of dark purple berries. Ht. 2m x 2m</p>	£15.00 £20.00	2L 5L
<p><b>Canna 'Phasion' (v)</b> Stunning Canna Lily with large deep orange flowers in summer and early autumn. Large bronze-purple leaves, striped with pink, ageing to shades of pink and orange. Clump forming perennial, ideal for borders and containers. Ht.1.2m x 0.8m</p>	£14.50	2L
<p><b>Ceratostigma willmottianum FOREST BLUE AGM</b> Bushy, spreading deciduous shrub forming mat of slender red stems and bright green leaves. Spiky red buds and cobalt blue flowers linger from July to late autumn. Long lasting rich red autumn foliage. Ht.0.8m x 1m</p>	£14.95	2L
<p><b>Chaenomeles speciosa 'Geisha Girl' (d) AGM</b> Compact deciduous shrub with glossy dark green leaves. Attractive semi-double salmon-pink flowers borne on bare branches in early spring. Followed by fragrant green-yellow fruits in autumn. Ht. 1m x 1m</p>	£15.95	2L
<p><b>Chaenomeles speciosa 'Moerloosei' AGM</b> Deciduous shrub with glossy dark green leaves. Masses of white flowers flushed deep pink, in spring. Good crop of golden-green fragrant quince fruits in autumn. Ht. 1.5m x 2.5m</p>	£15.95	2L
<p><b>Chaenomeles speciosa 'Yukigoten'</b> Well branched deciduous shrub with dark green leaves. Ideal trained against a wall or free standing in borders. Early spring flowering with elegant double greenish white flowers. Aromatic yellow fruits into the autumn. Ht.2.5m x 2m</p>	£15.95	2L

<p><b>Choisya x dewitteana WHITE DAZZLER 'Londaz' (PBR) AGM</b> Useful compact evergreen shrub with aromatic, very slender dark green leaves divided into leaflets. Exceptionally free-flowering with scented white flowers in spring, often repeated in late summer and autumn. Ht.60cm x 60cm</p>	£12.95	2L
<p><b>Cistus x dansereaui 'Decumbens' AGM</b> Small, low-growing, evergreen shrub with dark green leaves. Abundance of showy white flowers with small maroon blotch at the base of each petal. Ht.75cm x 1m</p>	£14.95	2L
<p><b>Cistus creticus subsp. Incanus</b> Compact, bushy evergreen shrub with mid-green wavy-edged leaves. Showy pink flowers with yellow stamens at the centre. Profuse flowering over a long period from late spring through to summer. Ht. 1m x 1m</p>	£14.95	2L
<p><b>Cistus x obtusifolius 'Thrive'</b> Compact, rounded, evergreen shrub with dense mound of mid-green foliage. Elegant white flowers with yellow centre. Very profuse flowering over a long period in summer. Ht.60cm x 1m</p>	£14.95	2L
<p><b>Cistus x purpureus AGM</b> Evergreen rock rose with rounded habit and soft green leaves. Large, tissue-thin, dark pink flowers throughout summer. Maroon blotch at the base of each petal and yellow anthers. Ht.80cm x 80cm</p>	£14.95 £20.00	2L 5L
<p><b>Cistus x purpureus 'Alan Fradd'</b> Evergreen rock rose with rounded habit and soft green leaves. Large-flowered cultivar with tissue-thin white flowers throughout summer. Maroon blotch at the base of each petal and yellow anthers. Ht.75cm x 75cm</p>	£14.95	2L
<p><b>Clematis DAIYU (Boulevard Series) (PBR)</b> Beautiful, compact, and free-flowering deciduous climber with dark to mid-green leaves. Large, rich cerise, single flowers that bloom freely from May to September. Ideal for obelisks and containers. Ht.1.2m x 60cm</p>	£15.00	2L
<p><b>Clematis 'Kokonoe' (PBR)</b> Showy free-flowering deciduous climber with dark to mid-green leaves. Luxurious, deep purple flowers from June to October. First flowers emerge as singles, but later blooms are doubles with an inner ruff-like ring or tepals. Ht. 2m x 1m</p>	£15.00	2L

<p><b>Clematis NINON (Boulevard Series) (PBR)</b> Beautiful, compact, and free-flowering deciduous climber. Dark to mid-green leaves. Large single white flowers, with reddish anthers, that bloom freely from June to November. Ideal for obelisks and containers. Ht. 1.2m x 80cm</p>	£15.00	2L

<p><b>Clematis NUBIA (Boulevard Series) (PBR)</b> Beautiful, compact, and free-flowering deciduous climber. Dark to mid-green leaves. Very large deep-red flowers, with darker red anthers, that bloom freely from May to September. Ideal for obelisks and containers. Ht. 1.5m x 80cm</p>	£15.00	2L
<p><b>Clematis 'Piilu' (EL)</b> Deciduous climber with mid-green leaves. Large pale pink flowers with dark pink central band to petals and creamy-white anthers.
